As part of the registration process for participation at the Orange Region Farmers' Market, all stallholders are required to be fully informed of and to adhere to the regulations pertaining to the Market Charter.

A copy of the 2008 Market Charter is enclosed for your reference. Also attached is a copy of the "Statement of Acceptance" form which is to be completed and signed by the principal producer/ representative, and **returned to the Market manager prior to the next market.** (The completed form can be handed in at the next scheduled market or posted, if you will not be in attendance at the next market.)

It is recommended that you retain a copy of the completed Acceptance form for your own records.

The Orange Region Farmers' Market has a reputation as one of the best Farmers' Markets in the country, due to the authenticity of our produce. It is the aim of the Market Management committee in conjunction with all those involved with the market to ensure that the high standard of the market is maintained.

You are therefore advised that only produce which you have grown / produced can be sold at the markets. Any produce which the Committee feels does not reflect the spirit of the Charter will be removed.

Should you have any concerns regarding the requirements of the Market Charter you are encouraged to contact the Market Manager or any member of the Market Management Committee.
